

**BOONAH SHOW SOCIETY**  
**SHOW ED FRIDAY 2<sup>ND</sup> JUNE, 2017**

**AIM OF SHOW ED:-**

- To educate Students that there is more to shows than Sideshows/Show Rides, Fairy Floss & Sample Bags and spending a lot of money! While all these things are part of the traditional Show, and it would not be a Show without them, we would like to show Students the other side of their local Show.
- To give Students the basic understanding of how to prepare and present exhibits, how to use their show schedule, what Judges are looking for, and background information of some of our most important primary producers, such as dairy, agriculture, cattle, poultry etc.
- The opportunity to awaken a desire to learn new skills, and to instil an appreciation of the skills and effort put in by the many exhibitors in all the different Sections of the Show.
- To understand the tradition and importance of their local Country Show, enabling them to appreciate the work and effort it takes to stage such an event.

**SENIOR CLASSES – Years 4,5,6 & 7** (2 Separate Sessions with 5 different Classes + 1 free time) full Day. 12 Classes in total.

**SESSION 1**

- **Stud Cattle – Cattle Handlers.** Basic instruction on handling and grooming cattle for shows. Would have cattle to demonstrate.
- **Agriculture** – A sample of the 4 classes in the Schedule. What they are, how they grow, what they are used for.
- **Woodwork** – Presentation by Woodworkers Group. Display and basic information on different tools and techniques.
- **Dairy Cattle** - Presentation by a local Dairy Farmer.
- **Apiculture** - Presentation by local Bee Keepers.

**SESSION 2**

- **Dairy Goats** - Basic instruction on handling, milking and information on the breeds of Dairy Goats and their uses.
- **Poultry** – Basic instruction on different breeds of poultry and preparing them for showing.
- **Horses** - Basic instruction to demonstrate horse handling and grooming, preparing the horse & rider for showing.
- **Fruit & Vegetables** - Display & presentation of locally grown produce.
- **Photography** - Basic demonstration on how to take a good photograph, prepare it for showing and selecting the correct class to enter.

**JUNIOR CLASSES Prep, Years 1,2 & 3** (2 Separate Sessions, with 3 different Classes + 1 Free Time.) Half Day each. Morning & Afternoon Sessions. Free time will overlap for both Sessions. 12 Classes in total.

**SESSION 3 Morning and Afternoon Sessions**

- **Fine Art** – Everyone can be an artist! Basic demonstration on how to prepare your art for exhibiting, entering into the correct class, artists tips. Painting their Sample Bag.
- **Foods** - Basic demonstration on exhibiting cooking, Decorating Arrowroot biscuits. Recipe and hints on presenting exhibits and following the schedule.
- **Australia Bush Buddies/Reptiles** - Presentation by Bush Buddies Wildlife-Reptile Group

**SESSION 4 Morning and Afternoon Sessions**

- **Horticulture** – basic demonstration on preparing an exhibit.
- **Craft** - Basic information on making a craft item. Origami Box with lid.
- **RSPCA Emu Van** – Interactive activities

Each Student will receive a Sample Bag containing a Junior Show Schedule for 2018 (Please keep me), a pencil, and the Seniors will also receive information on Paddock to Plate from Agforce. They will also receive a handout/give a way from each session they attend. Cost for Primary School Children is free. Year 7's will cost \$5-00, but they receive an Armband which gives them free entry for Friday Night Show, allowing them to compete in the Junior Young Farmers Challenge, which will be held in the Main Arena between the Trotting Program, commences at 4 p.m. and finishing with Fireworks at 8 p.m. Show Rides and all Pavilions/Food Stalls will all be open.
