- **PROJECT INFORMATION:- INDUSTRIAL TECHNOLOGY CONSTRUCTION**
 - * There will be two separate classes—Middle School Class (Yr 7 -Yr10) & a Senior School Class (Yr 11-Yr 12)
 - * Maximum of 3 entries per school
 - * To be developed from the woodwork/metalwork curriculum.
 - * Size cannot exceed the base foot print of 50cm x 50cm, maximum height of 1m high.
