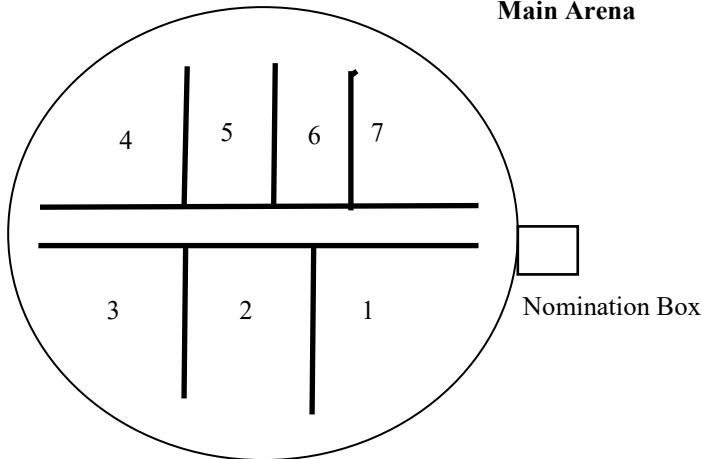

**THIS IS AN EQUESTRIAN QUEENSLAND AFFILIATED EVENT
AND WILL BE CONDUCTED UNDER EA RULES.**

Any class which includes fences 1.05m or above are considered to be an “above the line” class, regardless of any other entry restriction imposed on these classes.

It is a requirement for these classes that:

- The rider holds a current Competitor membership with EA
- The horse is life/full registered with EA
- The horse has a current EA jumping competition licence

Classes of 1m and below are considered “below the line”. These classes do not require horse registration or a competition licence BUT any riders competing in these classes MUST BE at least a Participant member of EA.

All competitors compete at their own risk.

All riders must wear helmets that comply with the EA Helmet standards.

Horses may only enter in maximum of two classes per day or one Championship Class.
