

- 1 The Boonah Show Society adopts Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies Rules in relation to the exhibiting of Horses at Agricultural Shows
- 2. A HEALTH DECLARATION FORM MUST BE PROVIDED FOR ALL HORSES as per Bio-Security Hendra Virus Regulations. Forms available at the back of this Schedule or On Line or at the Nomination Box.
- 3. The attached Waiver & Rules Form must also be signed by the Competitor or Guardian before the Nomination will be accepted.
- Gates into the Arena will be kept shut at all times, and operated by a Steward to allow entry and exit by Exhibitors.
- 5. Competitors & horse are the only people allowed to enter the Arena.
- 6. If the Judge, Steward or Chief Steward believes a horse is not under control, the Exhibitor will be asked to leave the ring with the assistance of the Mounted Steward.
- 7. Horses must be attended by a handler at all times while they are on the grounds or in the arena, or securely stabled or yarded.
- 8 No electric fences are allowed on the grounds. These rules apply to both the showgrounds and parking area.
- 9. All horses winning ribbons are required to take part in the Grand Parade.
- 10. **Horses must be led** when crossing the road from the parking area to the show grounds.
- 11. Any questions re judging times or classes to be directed to the Class Calling Steward situated near the entrance to the showgrounds.
- 12. A Marshalling area has been provided opposite the entrance to the Arena.
- 13. A warm up arena for Jumpers is situated near the Parking area.
