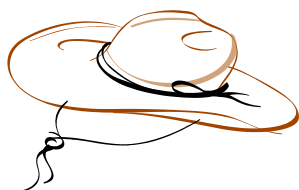

All events are held under QCAS Horse Rules. These Rules are available on the Website, at the Nomination Box or from the Show Secretary upon request

ALL EXHIBITORS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YRS MUST WEAR APPROVED HELMETS

They must be A.S.A 3838 or equivalent

Horses to be either Hack or Hunter- cannot be both. Hunters to wear plain brow band

No one other than the Horse & Rider are allowed in the arena

If the Judge, Steward or Chief Horse Steward believes a Horse is not under control, the Exhibitor will be asked to leave the Ring, with the assistance of the Mounted Steward

All horses must be led from the shoulder

All Horses competing in Led Classes must be Registered with their appropriate Breed Organisation

Judges have the right to request to sight these papers

It is the **SOLE RESPONSIBILITY** of competitors to present their horses in time for their classes

The Committee reserves the right to change the order of the classes before or during the show
