1. Work must not have been exhibited at any previous show of the Boonah Show Society.
2. All entries to have been completed in the last two (2) years
3. Collections to be sewn or pinned together to avoid being lost.
4. All possible care and attention is taken with all entered exhibits, but the Boonah Show Society accepts NO responsibility for missing or damaged articles.
5. Work not to be washed, unless it is part of the work process..
6. Worn, used or soiled work will not be accepted.
7. All entries must be hand-worked by the named exhibitor, unless otherwise stated.
8. In all classes the judge will take into consideration the quality of the work in making the awards, which may result in **NO** 1st prize being awarded. All prizes are awarded at the Judges discretion, and are final.
9. All junior exhibitors are required to enter their date of birth on their entry forms to ensure they are placed in the correct class.
10. No more than two (2) entries allowed for each exhibitor in each class.
11. If an item is entered in the incorrect class, the head stewards will re-class it.
12. Definition: Any article of work not mentioned, if the item is specified in another class, additional items cannot be entered
13. One class entry per line and a clear description of each exhibit is required.
